Known as "the mother of modern nursing education", \*Florence Nightingale started to study nursing in Germany, and began rebuilding a charity hospital in the United Kingdom in 1853.

In 1854, the Crimean War broke out. Nightingale was appointed by the British government as a 40-member division leader, and she went to the battlefield. In the Crimean War, (1) <u>she also \*expressed</u> <u>her idea to the \*politicians in order to \*improve the dirty situation</u> and inadequate treatment, and she succeeded in her performance. The injured soldiers called her a "battlefield angel."

After the war ended, she was called a hero in England, and at a meeting with Queen Victoria, she insisted on "improving the hospital on the battlefield." (2) <u>Since then, the death rate of injured people has</u> <u>decreased on the \*battlefield</u>.

She devoted herself to nursing education until she died at the age of 90.
